ATLANTIC CITY — Atlantic City varsity player Casey Brennan and partner Bill Law survived a 2-6, 6-4, 7-6 scare from Don Haycock and Carol Miller in the opening round of the \$5,000 Jersey Devil Tennis Tournament, which began a two-week run at Golf and Tennis World Tuesday night.

In other opening night matches, Walt and Karen Skulski of Somers Point tripped Stu Segal and Phyllis Friedenbergs 7-6, 6-0; the Vineland tandem of Skip and Patti Liebenow bested James and Barbara Ruff 6-2 6-1 while Joe Rossen and Laurie Kennedy downed Tom and JoAnn Deacon 6-3 6-0.

All the matches were in the 'B' flight of the two-tiered tournament. Play in the 'A' flight of the mixed doubles tournament begins tonight at 7 p.m., highlighted by the second-seeded pair of Hal Tendler and Stephanie McAvoy Tendler. The top seeds, Chuck Haley and Shirley McAvoy play their first round match on Friday night.
